Spread of COVID-19	Staff and clients are at risk of developing COVID-19 from direct contact with contaminated surfaces or from air-borne bacteria.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Good hand hygiene: Ensure that staff are washing hands regularly when treating clients and between every client. Also encouraging clients to use hand sanitiser when entering and leaving the clinic.• Cleaning of equipment and clinic room: Staff responsible for the cleaning and sanitising of all equipment and areas used before and after each client. This includes light switches, door handles and chairs ensuring appropriate antibacterial products are used to complete this.• PPE: Staff to wear face masks when treating clients and encourage clients to do the same. Follow all government guidelines in terms of required PPE if they should change.• Positive COVID-19 cases: Staff are to follow current government guidance on the action to take should a member or staff or client test positive for	All staff Clients are responsible for following recommendations set by EJ Rehab staff in terms of COVID-19, should clients not wish to follow these guidelines it is up to the member of staff's discretion as to whether to assess/treat the patient.

		<p>COVID-19. Clients are required to notify EJ Rehab should they test positive before attending appointment or if they have tested positive within 14 days of their appointment at EJ Rehab.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ventilation: Where possible ensure all rooms are well ventilated by opening the window. • Social distancing: Where possible staff are to maintain a good distance from clients. Where this cannot occur due to practicality staff are to ensure that all other measures are followed eg ventilation and appropriate PPE is worn. • Sharing of equipment: Limit the sharing of equipment where possible- when this is not possible equipment should be cleaned thoroughly. Clients will be required to bring their own towels to the appointment.
